




## Reconstruction for Future Growth

# Tips for Managing ANY Project



There are some common themes that run through any project, be that for an offshore wind farm or a simple system update. Here are a few tips to help keep things under control.

**Management** – who is ultimately responsible for delivery as it is essential you have a defined line of command, so you know where the buck stops.

**Resources** – what materials, equipment, licenses, or insurance do you need. Whether large or small, list the items and any resource limitations or delivery timescales to ensure you have what is needed.

**Objective and Scope** – these need to be defined and documented with processes mapped so that there is no confusion as to what is IN and OUT of scope. This will avoid lengthy disputes or extra costs mid-project.

**Communications** – define a rhythm and method of communications. It is no good if everyone expects an email once a week and instead, they receive a WhatsApp message once a month. Tailored communications are required for different audiences; those who need details, those who need the technical explanations and those who need an executive overview.

**Project Management** – the process and tools being used should form part of the management strategy on how the project is to be delivered and communicating this to the team will set expectations of what everyone can expect.

**Sustainability** – this looks at the ongoing maintenance to keep the infrastructure working post implementation and this will reduce long-term costs. It also refers to the impact on the environment, waste management, etc.

**Schedule and Budget** – obviously deadlines need to be reached while remaining in budget however, sometimes the unforeseen happens and the most important aspect of managing this is communications. Don't wait and hope things will get back on track – keep everyone informed.

**Stakeholder Management** – all parties need the opportunity to voice their objectives and expectations, and this can enable everyone to be onboard and invested in the project. Leaving anyone out is the quickest way to generate conflict.
